# "Surrender Your Agenda"

The South West Peninsula District of the Methodist Church encouraged all of its Circuits to do something radical over Lent this year. We were given the opportunity to move the focus on church life from the practical and the business mode to the spiritual and the work of God's Kingdom. I would suggest that we did not make the most of this opportunity and most people reading this were blissfully unaware that such a move was taking place. I believe that unless we get the spiritual side of our work and call right we will never succeed in any other part of our work to any great degree.

As a Circuit Leadership Team, we have discussed why many of our activities are so poorly attended, especially when much effort has often gone into the planning. I suggested that two possible reasons are:

- (1) The product is not good enough or relevant enough or
- (2) perhaps we are not really committed enough to the "Heavenly Vision" as the apostle Paul described our mission. In a quarter that includes Pentecost Sunday we are reminded again that God will give of Himself, the Holy Spirit, to equip us for the challenge of proclaiming the Good News of the Kingdom of God, to those who ask and seek Him. If our Churches close in the coming days it will not be because Heaven stopped supplying but rather that we stopped asking in prayer for God's guidance and power.

Jesus said how much more would the Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask.
