A thought from Rev'd Jeff

Last month saw the death of Brian Wilson, one of the iconic figures in pop music when I was a teenager, a founding member of the Beach Boys. In the mid-1990s some of a youth fellowship took me to see the Beach Boys at the NEC in Birmingham. They were no longer the blond-haired surf dudes, but grey-haired middle-aged men who could still harmonize incredibly well, and capture images of sun-soaked beaches and surfing, fast cars and fun. But there was, at least for me, poignancy, like looking at a faithful dog who ran at your side as a puppy but now limps slowly on painful hips. There is a Scripture which says, "The summer is now over, the harvest is gathered, but we are not yet saved." It is a challenge for us to enjoy life, work and play, but also prepare for the day when the music stops.
